

# Entry Level 2 Award Assisting with Basic Care of Horses

Learner will complete practical assessments and assignments for all 4 units to achieve this qualification.

- Recognise colours, markings, and points of the horse.
- Assist with providing food and water for horses.
- Assist with skipping out a stable.
- Recognise basic signs of health.

## **Progression**

Learners taking the Entry Level 2 Award in Assisting with Basic Care of Horses, may also be interested in taking the following:

- Entry Level 3 Award in Catching and Leading, Grooming and Rugging up a Horse
- Entry Level 3 Award in Putting on and Cleaning Saddle and Bridle.

Following achievement of any of these qualifications, learners will be able to progress onto the following:

• Level 1 Diploma in Work Based Horse Care.
