Learner will complete practical assessments and assignments for all 4 units to achieve this qualification.

- Recognise a saddle and bridle
- Clean horse tack.
- Apply a saddle and bridle to a horse under supervision.
- Assist with cleaning horse clothing.

Progression

Learners taking the Entry Level 3 Award in Recognising, Putting on and Cleaning Saddle and Bridle, may also be interested in taking the following:

- Entry Level Award In Basic Care of Horses (Entry 2)
- Entry Level Award in Catching and Leading, Grooming and Rugging Up a Horse (Entry 3)

Following achievement of any of these qualifications, learners will be able to progress onto the following:

- Level 1 Diploma in Work Based Horse Care.
