Functional Skills Qualification English and Maths Level 1

The Functional Skills qualifications in English and Maths at Level 1 are ideal for learners wishing to develop practical, transferable skills in English and Maths, to work confidently, effectively, and independently in life. They're suitable for a wide range of individuals and is fundamental to the successful completion of various wider qualifications.

Guided Learning Hours: 45, including taught sessions and portfolio work.

Entry Requirements

- Learners aged 14 or older.
- Learners not to have attained a level 1 functional skills, GCSE in English

Course Tutor:

This course is delivered by qualified and experienced functional skills tutors, including specialist learning support tutors.

Course Overview

- An initial and diagnostic assessment to determine individual learning requirements.
- Registration onto maths and English online learning programme.
- Weekly, 2-hour individual, or small group sessions with our functional skills tutor at Happy Hooves Riding Centre.
- 1-1 tutor support throughout the learning programme.
- Allocated weekly self-study time at Happy Hooves Riding Centre.
- Reviews of progress each term.
- Sharing useful maths and English activities in the workplace with Coaches and Instructors at Happy Hooves to support learning.
- Mock Assessment sessions and exam technique preparation
- Final Maths and English Assessments at Happy Hooves.

Duration

Each functional skills will be delivered over 15 weeks. If a learner is completing both functional skills, the learning programme will be delivered over 30 weeks.



Assessment

Functional Skills English qualifications are comprised of 3 mandatory paper-based, or online assessment components:

- Speaking, Listening and Communication – Internally Assessed
- Reading – Externally Assessed
- Writing – Externally Assessed

Functional Skills Maths qualifications have one external paper-based or online assessment divided into 2 sections:

- Section A: The non-calculator section
- Section B: The calculator section

Course Content

Functional Skills English covers three components:

- Speaking, listening and Communication in formal and informal discussions and exchanges that include unfamiliar subjects.
- Reading and understanding a range of straightforward texts.
- Writing a range of texts to communicate information, ideas and opinions, using formats and styles suitable for their purpose and audience.

Functional Skills Maths covers the following components:

- Using Numbers and the number system
- Using common measures, shape, and space
- Handling information and data.

Progression

Following achievement of this qualification, progression opportunities include:

- Level 2 Maths Functional Skills.
- Level English Functional Skills
